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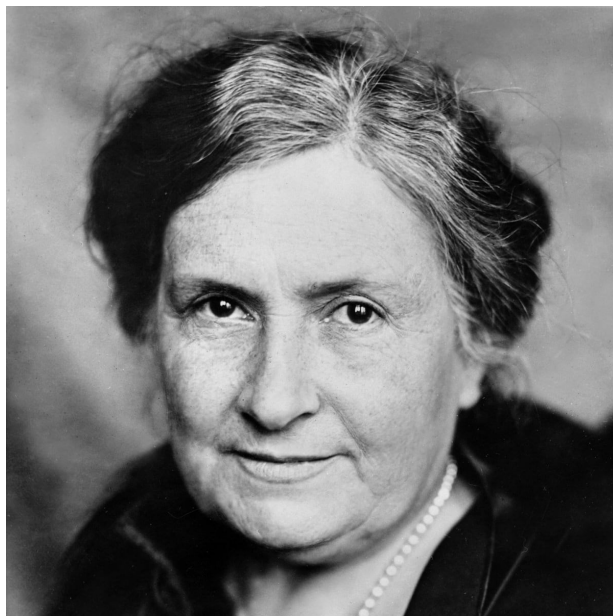
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Maria Montessori

Born in 1870, Maria Montessori became the first female physician in Italy. She is known for being ahead of her time. She is also known for being a teacher, a humanitarian, and for her advocacy for equality on gender issues. She was a pioneering Italian educator who developed an interest to help autistic children and children with special needs. She built her school, Casa de Bambini, for underprivileged children with the intent of giving these children the opportunity to learn by their own motivation. Her work and close observation of children enabled them to score above average in reading and writing skills; this was unheard of in her time. She dedicated the rest of her life to helping children learn and develop their full potential without them even knowing it. She believes that children have a natural tendency to learn and understand the world around them. When the environment fulfills this need, children are happy to learn and become independently, self-sufficient individuals.

The Montessori Method is used internationally and is usually held in high regard amongst educators, parents, and most importantly, the children.
